

MATCHDAY SLO TEAM



SENSORY ROOM


We have a bespoke Sensory Room based in the Family Section, for young fans who may need to take a little time out on a matchday with our fully trained helpers.

GETTING HERE

BY CAR

The stadium is off the A4074 and is signposted on all major approach roads to Oxford with the brown “attraction” sign showing a football icon. For Satnavs, use postcode OX4 4XP. The stadium has unreserved spaces for around 2,000 cars at each game. Parking is free of charge and on a first come, first served basis. If the main car parks are full, you will be directed to the overflow carpark which is past the VUE cinema and club shop.

BY TRAIN AND BUS

The nearest station is Oxford (OXF). If you arrive at Oxford Parkway (OXP), we suggest you take a connecting train to Oxford Station which is approximately five miles from the stadium. From Oxford Station both the City5 and Stagecoach1 bus services run every five minutes from bus stop R2 to Sandy Lane West. The journey takes around 40 minutes and then it is a 15 minute walk to the stadium (see [City 5/Stagecoach 1 Timetable](#)).

From Oxford City Centre the 3A runs every half hour from [bus stop E1](#) near the Westgate shopping centre, and Oxford High Street stop T2. It takes around 35 minutes and stops at Grenoble Road on the south side of the stadium. There are also a number of Football special routes on matchdays from Didcot, Carterton, Kidlington, Bicester and Thame.

BY BIKE

DISABLED SUPPORTERS


There are specific marked bays for disabled supporters near each stand on a first-come, first-served basis.
