	<p>FAB agreed with the Club that a meeting was not needed to provide feedback on ticketing and memberships as there was limited feedback regarding the current membership offering. JB provided a written summary of the feedback to the club. A face-to-face meeting will be held to review proposals for 2026-27.</p> <p>Oxvox have been working on a date for the fans forum in the second half of March. This will be confirmed and communicated in due course.</p>

<b>4</b>	<b>Working Group Updates</b>	
	<p><b>Accessibility</b></p> <p>An online meeting will be taking place on Weds 4th March with Level Playing Field. The aim is to set out a route map for establishing a DSA. A number of supporters have expressed interest in setting this up.</p> <p><b>Matchday</b></p> <p>An initial meeting was conducted on 3rd February. AK noted that many matchday issues are dealt with routinely by the Matchday SLO team and via his SLO duties, and that few items were being raised for the working group agenda. It was agreed that as we move towards a new stadium, this working group would become more pertinent.</p> <p><b>New Stadium</b></p> <p>The S106 is ready to be signed and should be announced imminently.</p> <p><b>Ticketing</b></p> <p>See above regarding feedback. A meeting date to discuss new proposals has been agreed as Wednesday 25th March at 7pm.</p>

	<p>BH noted a query regarding the dress code for individuals, especially children, wearing home shirts in the hospitality boxes. AK explained that there is a dress code for the hospitality areas. This will be added to the agenda for the meeting with the club's commercial department later in the year.</p> <p>JB had received feedback regarding engagement with the ultras, pre match music playlist and half-time entertainment. These will be sent to AK and the matchday team.</p> <p>GB raised feedback regarding where coaches were parked for away games, especially considering disabled fans. 	<p><u>Commercial Survey</u> The commercial team provided sight of a comprehensive survey that is due to be sent out to fans. FAB members reviewed the survey and provided feedback including a notable concern about the length of the survey and the relevance of some questions. A document of all the feedback will be provided to the club.</p> <p><u>Individual representatives</u> MOD and OG are due to step down from their individual representative roles at the end of the season. Both are allowed to stand again for election. An appointments committee will need to be created from the other individuals' reps, AK and an FSA representative.</p> <p><u>Group representation</u> It was noted that any recognised fan group would be welcome to have a member join the FAB as there are spaces reserved for them within the FAB structure.</p>	JB
